Practice Class: In this series, not only will we continue to explore shape, value, and color, but look deeper into texture from smooth to rough, shade, shadow, highlight and reflection, soft and hard edges.

For this series, we will use Water forms for our subjects because it was the most mentioned in last Fall's evaluation. We will look at water from mist and drops to puddles, lakes, and water falls.

Students will work from their own reference material, deciding how and where various components are to be used.

Practice classes on water forms begin on Tuesday, April 2nd and continue on Tuesdays April 9, 16, 23, and 30.
